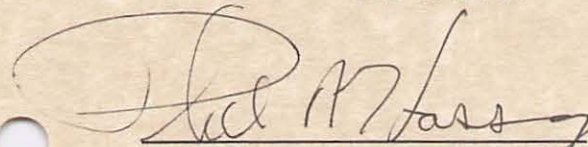

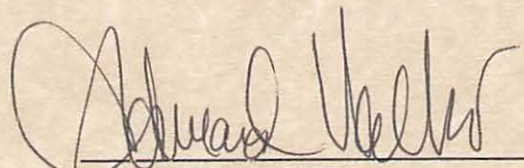
- WHEREAS, our daily news is dominated by stories of crime, violence, and disaster, too often leaving average citizens with feelings of despair and helplessness; and
