

## RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1999 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO, FOR THE 1999 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 9, 1998 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$2,178.51 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds and interest is \$0, and;

WHEREAS, the 1999, valuation for assessment for the Town of Crestone as certified by the County Assessor is \$281 570.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO:

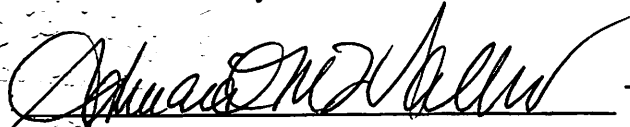
Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Crestone during the 1999 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 7.737 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Crestone for the year 1999.

Section 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Town of Crestone during the 1999 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Crestone for the year 1999

Section 3. That the Town Manager/Treasurer of the Town of Crestone is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Saguache County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Crestone as hereinabove determined and set
