

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-007

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-009 (AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2001-1 (AN ORDINANCE ENACTING PROCEDURES AND RULES OF ORDER MANUAL FOR THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE))

WHEREAS, at the October 10, 2011, Town Board of Trustees meeting of the Town of Crestone, the Town Board of Trustees adopted the following policy:

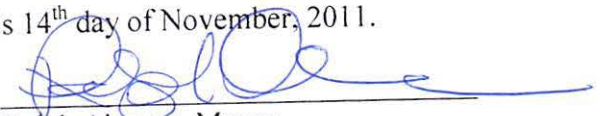
“The Town of Crestone is an Equal Employment Opportunity employer. The Town does not discriminate against applicants, employees, or in its provision of services on the basis of race, age, gender, color, religion, national origin, disability, military or marital status, sexual orientation, gender expression, genetic information, or any other status protected by applicable state or local law. The Town prohibits retaliation against any employee for filing a complaint under this policy or for assisting in complaint investigation. By the adoption of this statement, the Town reaffirms its intent to adhere to the non-discrimination standards in state and federal laws.”; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager, along with the Town Attorney, have reviewed the Procedures and Rules of Order Manual, eliminating words that are gender specific.

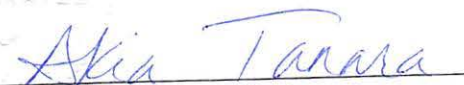

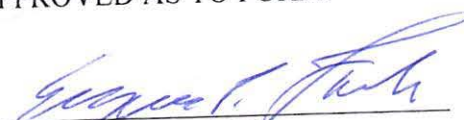
