

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-006

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2012-001
[AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2006-013
(AN ORDINANCE REPEALING EXISTING ZONING ORDINANCES OF
THE TOWN OF CRESTONE AND ENACTING
NEW ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN)
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 2009-009]

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-001 amended Ordinances 2006-013 and 2009-009 enacting comprehensive zoning regulations for the Town of Crestone, by regulating the size of political signage, but did not regulate the number of such signs; and

WHEREAS, such signage is causing visual clutter and is not consistent with the spirit and purpose of the Crestone Zoning Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that Ordinance 2012-001 is amended to read as follows:

REGULATION XI: SIGNS

Sec. XI-5 Sign Categories and Size Limitations

(j) Political signs are signs displayed on private property in accordance with an official election or erected on behalf of candidates for public office:

- 3) Signage in the commercial district shall not exceed 16 square feet total or 4 feet in height. ***Only one (1) political sign may be displayed on each contiguous ownership parcel for each candidate or issue in support or opposition thereof.**
- 4) Signage in the residential district shall not exceed 9 square feet total or 3 feet in height. ***Only one (1) political sign may be displayed on each contiguous ownership parcel for each candidate or issue in support or opposition thereof.**

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH AND SAFETY DUE TO AMBIGUITY IN INTERPRETATION AND RESULTING VISUAL CLUTTER AND SHALL

BECOME EFFECTIVE AND BE ENFORCED FROM AND AFTER PASSAGE OF THE SAME.
