

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-003

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #2010-007
AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 2009-009
RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA
AND INFUSED PRODUCT DISPENSARIES

WHEREAS, Ordinance #2009-009 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2006-013 (An Ordinance Repealing Existing Zoning Ordinances of the Town of Crestone and Enacting New Zoning Regulations for the Town) provided for medical cannabis dispensaries as a conditional use of property in the Residential Low-Density (RL) District and Ordinance 2010-007 provided for medical marijuana centers and medical marijuana infused products businesses as conditional uses in the Commercial (C) District zoning classifications of the town; and

WHEREAS, the town has passed Ordinance 2016-002 on June 11, 2016, which amended Ordinance 2013-001 (which imposed a temporary moratorium on designated marijuana stores and allowed the operation of retail marijuana stores and provided for taxing of the same), and

WHEREAS, the allowance of retail marijuana establishments and taxation of the same subsumed the necessity for medical marijuana establishments and provides a tax base not otherwise provided by medical marijuana establishments; and

WHEREAS, there are no current licensed medical marijuana establishments within the town which would be affected by the provisions of this ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that:

- 1. Ordinance 2009-009 is amended by repealing Section IV-303 Conditional Uses (f) Medical Cannabis Dispensaries**
- 2. Ordinance #2010-007 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance #2009-009 Amendment to paragraphs (f) of Sec. IV – 303 Conditional Uses Dealing with Medical Marijuana Centers and Infused Products Businesses) is repealed in its entirety.**
- 3. Medical Marijuana Centers, stores and medical marijuana infused product facilities are not allowed as permitted nor conditional uses in any zoned area of the town nor upon any property in the town which may not be zoned.**

SAGUACHE COUNTY 2016 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT QUESTION: BALLOT QUESTION 1A: MARIJUANA EXCISE TAX

The following County Referendum will be a Ballot Question on the November 8, 2016 General Election:

Shall Saguache County increase taxes by \$350,000 annually in the first full fiscal year and by such amounts as are raised thereafter as authorized by Colorado Revised Statutes 29-2-114 through the imposition of an excise tax of 5% of the average market rate, as determined by the Colorado Department of Revenue, on the first sale or transfer of unprocessed retail marijuana by a retail marijuana cultivation facility located within Saguache County, with such revenues to be used as determined by the Board of County Commissioners of Saguache County to fund, among other programs, Youth services, land use code enforcement, county infrastructure, marijuana administration costs, and other General Purposes of the County; and shall such earnings thereon be collected, retained, and expended as a voter-approved revenue change without limitation or condition under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution or C.R.S. 29-1-301, as amended, or any other law, all in conformance with Saguache County Resolution G-2016-3?
