

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-003

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL 0.5% SALES TAX INCREASE IN THE TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO, ON THE SALE OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AT RETAIL AND PRESCRIBING THE USE OF PROCEEDS THEREFROM

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2000-1 increased the Town of Crestone sales tax upon the sale of tangible personal property at retail to three percent (3%) by virtue of a vote of the Town electorate on April 4, 2000, with the resulting proceeds to be deposited into the Town's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 013-2019 of the Town Board of Trustees referred the issue of an increase of the Town's sales tax of 0.5% to the Town electorate with the proceeds therefrom to be deposited in to the water and sewer enterprise funds and used for operational expenses and which issue was approved by the electorate on April 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution states that if approved, the Town Board of Trustees would pass an ordinance allowing the collection of sales tax at retail at a rate of 3.5%, upon tangible personal property sold within the Town.

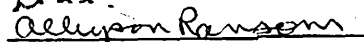
NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado, that the additional increment of 0.5% sales tax be levied on the sale of personal property with the Town (resulting in a total sales tax of 3.5%) effective April 7, 2020 and that said 0.5% be deposited in to the water and sewer enterprise funds and used for operational expenses.

DONE, and **SIGNED** this 9th day of November, 2020, *nunc pro tunc to April 7, 2020*.

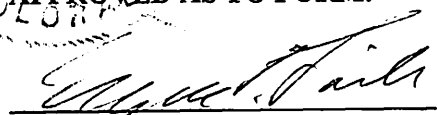
