

RESOLUTION NO. 017-2022

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE
ACCOMODATING DEVICES SUCH AS ROLLERBLADES, SKATEBOARDS AND
COASTERS IN SPECIFICED AREAS**

WHEREAS, The Crestone Municipal Code, at Sec. 13-5-160 restricts the use of many devices upon any sidewalk, pedestrian path, park, or other public thoroughfare set aside for pedestrian traffic within the town; and,

WHEREAS, The Crestone Municipal Code, at Sec. 13-5-160, also allows the board of trustees to adopt by resolution, defined areas to accommodate these devices; and,

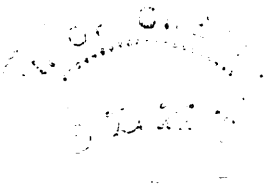
WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees now wishes to accommodate these devices in limited, specified areas of the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees now sets aside the north sidewalk of Silver Ave. between Alder Street and Cottonwood Street and the area of Little Pearl Park as areas that are especially defined to accommodate the devices described in the Creston Municipal Code at Sec. 13-5-160; and,

WHEREAS, no additional areas are set aside to accommodate the devices described in the Creston Municipal Code at Sec. 13-5-160.

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that the area of the north sidewalk of Silver Ave between Alder Street and Cottonwood Street and the area of Little Pearl Park as areas that are especially defined to accommodate the devices described in the Crestone Municipal Code at Sec. 13-5-160.
