

Resolution # 003-2023
Adopting the 2023 San Luis Valley
Hazard Mitigation Plan

Whereas, the Town of Crestone recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, the Town of Crestone resides within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Town of Crestone Board of Trustees hereby adopts the San Luis Valley Hazard Mitigation Plan, as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, the Town of Crestone will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval. While content related to The Town of Crestone may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require The Town of Crestone to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions at or before the end of the next five-year update cycle.
