

RESOLUTION NO. 003-2024

A RESOLUTION AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. 004-2017:
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES' PROCEDURES AND RULES OF ORDER OF THE TOWN OF
CRESTONE

WHEREAS, the Town of Crestone, Colorado, adopted Ordinance No. 2001-1 on December 18, 2001, which enacted a *Procedures and Rules of Order* Manual for the Town Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2008-004 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 2001-1, Enacting *Procedures and Rules of Order* Manual for the Town Board of the Town of Crestone) allows the Board of Trustees to approve amendments to said policy by Resolution of the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2010-009 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 2001-1, An Ordinance Enacting Procedures and Rules of Order) amended Sections 2.2, 3.1, 3.4, 3.5, 3.6, 3.8, 3.10, 3.11, 4.5, 5.2, 5.4, 7.2, 7.4, and 8.3 of the Procedure and Rules of Order; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2011-007 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 2010-009) adopted the Equal Employment Opportunity policy; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has recommended certain amendments to said manual and the Town Board of Trustees approves said recommendations;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that the *Town of Crestone Board of Trustees' Procedures and Rules of Order* be amended to read as follows:

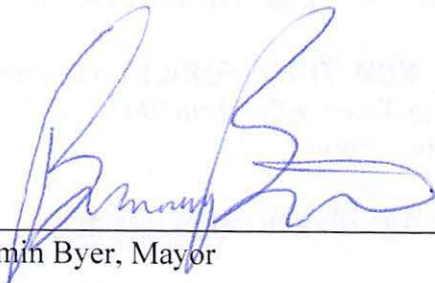

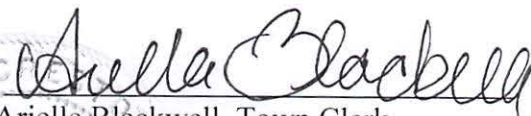
§ 7.3 Citizens' Comments
