

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-3

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING TERM LIMITS FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO

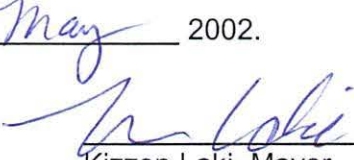
WHEREAS, resolution #001-2002 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado referred the issue of elimination of term limits for members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado to the Town electorate on April 2, 2002, and

WHEREAS, eighteen (18) persons voted to eliminate such term limits and eight (8) voted against eliminating such term limits, and

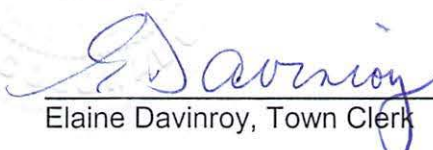
WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees declares the measure passed eliminating all term limits for the members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone, Colorado that term limits imposed by section eleven (11), Article XVIII of the Colorado Constitution are hereby eliminated and all duly elected members of the Board of Trustees either now serving in office or hereafter elected shall be subject reelection without term limits.

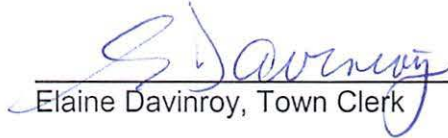
