

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-5

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone has reviewed the existing provisions of the Town ordinances concerning public safety and related offenses and have found the same to be antiquated and inadequate, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has received the recommendations from the Town Marshall and Town Attorney concerning an appropriate code of public safety, regarding offenses which are relevant to the appropriate functioning of the Town government and which are necessary for the peace, health, and safety of citizens of the Town, and

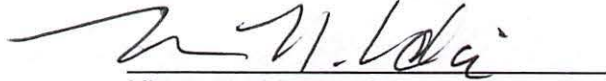
WHEREAS, in order to provide for consistency in interpretation and enforcement of ordinances of the Town relating to public safety, the Board of Trustees finds that certain existing ordinances should be repealed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone Colorado:

1. The following ordinances and sections of ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety:
 - a. Ordinance #15 (Ordinance defining and punishing vagrancy).
 - b. Ordinance #20 (Cruelty to Animals)
 - c. Ordinance #21 (Bawdy Houses)
 - d. Ordinance #22 (Prostitution)
 - e. Ordinance #23 (Prostitution)
 - f. Ordinance #24 (Dance Houses)
 - g. Ordinance #25 (Drunkenness)
 - h. Ordinance #26 (Breach of Peace)
 - i. Ordinance #27 (Giving liquor to minors)
 - j. Ordinance #28 (Impersonating a Peace Officer)
 - k. Ordinance #32 (Carrying a Concealed Weapon)
 - l. Ordinance #33 (Discharging firearm)
 - m. Weapons Control Ordinance (January 4, 1978)
 - n. Ordinance #1978-4 (General Offense Ordinance)

2. The Code of Offenses attached as Exhibit A, to which reference is made, is hereby enacted and adopted for the Town of Crestone, Colorado.
