

RESOLUTION 1988-1

A RESOLUTION CANCELING THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 5, 1988 AND DECLARING CERTAIN CANDIDATES ELECTED.

Whereas, there is now tentativley scheduled a municipal election to be held by the Town of Crestone on April 5, 1988, for the purpose of electing three persons to the office of member of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone and one person to fill the office of Mayor of Crestone. These vacancies are arising from the expiration of the terms of the present office holders.

And whereas, only four candidates, namely ROBERT KING, STEVEN McDOWELL, and PAM LUNT for Trustee, and MICHAEL DENNETT for Mayor have filed nomination petitions in the form and manner and within the time periods required by law and by the Town of Crestone Ordinance 1984-2.

And whereas, said Ordinance 1984-2, adopted by the Town of Crestone pursuant to CRS 31-10-507: provides that, if the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the Friday before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such an election, including candidate filing affidavits of intent, the Clerk shall certify such fact to the governing body, and it shall hold a meeting and may cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected.

And whereas, at the colse of business on the Friday immediately precedi ng the election, such being April 1, 1988, the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and there were not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Board of Trustees finds that the only matter before the voters with respect to the municipal election tentatively scheduled April 5, 1988, is the election of persons to office and that on the close of Business on Friday April 1, 1988, there were not more candidates than officed to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent.
2. That the Board of Trustees find that there are now three vacancies on the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone and one vacancy for Mayor of Crestone arising from termination of the term of office of four persons currently holding such offices.
3. That the Board of Trustees finds that there are now only three candidates, namely ROBERT KING, STEVEN McDOWELL and PAM LUNT running for councilpersons and one candidate, namely MICHAEL DENNETT running for Mayor, and such numbers being equal to the offices to be filled at such election.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

1. That pursuant to the terms and provisions of said ordinance No. 1984-2, The above named four candidates are declared to be duly qualified to assume the duties of the office of members of the Board of Trustees of the town of Crestone and Mayor of Crestone respectively and are hereby deemed to be duly elected for a four year term.
2. That notice of such cancellation shall be posted in order to inform the electors of the municipality. Such notice shall be posted at the polling place and in not less than one other place.
