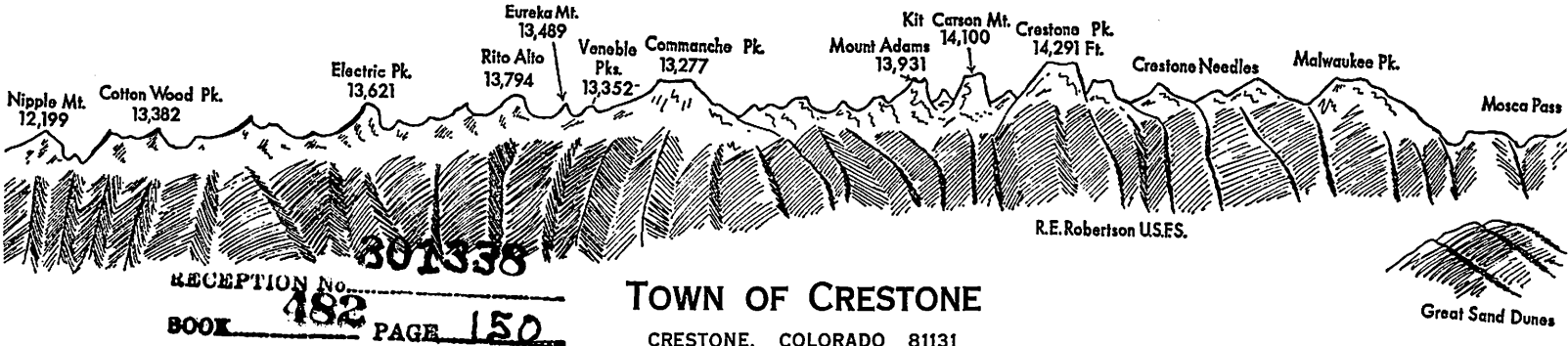

RESOLUTION 1992-1

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BOUNDARY SURVEY OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE  
MAP DATED OCTOBER 7, 1992 AS THE LEGAL AND OFFICIAL TOWN MAP OF THE  
TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees for Crestone, Colorado deemed it necessary to provide all citizens with a legal and official map of the Town of Crestone;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees hired Summit Engineering, 1317 State Avenue, Alamosa, Colorado to complete a survey of the four corners of the Town of Crestone, and to mark those said corners, and to revise the said map of those corners and the outer boundaries of the Town of Crestone;

WHEREAS, the Boundary Survey of the Town of Crestone has been completed and revised by Summit Engineering, dated October 7, 1992, and reviewed by all members of the Town Board of Crestone, Colorado;

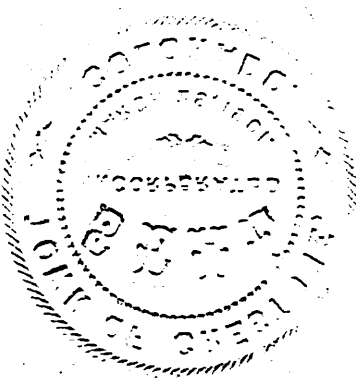
WHEREAS, at the monthly meeting of the Town Board of Trustees for Crestone, Colorado held on December 9, 1992, the Town Board of Trustees made this resolution and voted to adopt the Boundary Survey Map with the streets, alleys, and lots shown within, made by Summit Engineering, dated October 7, 1992, as the official plat of the incorporated Town of Crestone and that said map supersedes all prior plat maps of the Town of Crestone, and that such map be recorded at the Saguache County Court House as the official map of Crestone, Colorado.
