DUNES NATIONAL MONUMENT, AND

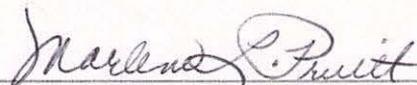
WHEREAS, THE TOWN BOARD OF CRESTONE FEELS A RESPONSIBILITY
TO ITS CITIZENS AND OTHERS WITHIN THE SURROUNDING AREA

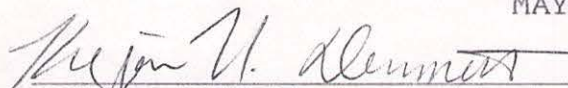
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE TOWN BOARD OF

ZONE, AND

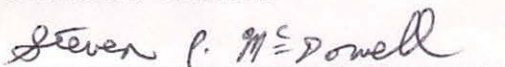
FURTHER, THAT THE TOWN BOARD DETERMINES ENACTMENT OF THIS

CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE AND THE SURROUNDING AREA.

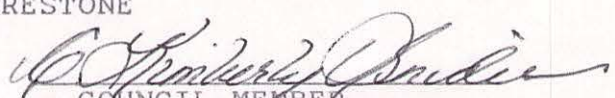

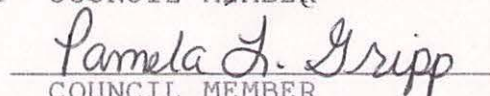
