

RESOLUTION 1994-2

WHEREAS, The Town of Crestone is required by Colorado Statue 29-22-102(3), as amended, to designate an emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents occurring within the corporate limits of Crestone; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Crestone as the Board of Health finds is necessary to protect the public health and safety of the residents of Crestone;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CRESTONE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY, resolves to designate the Northern Saguache County Fire Protection District and the Hazmat Team from the Alamosa Office of the Colorado State Patrol, by a mutual aid agreement, to be the Designated Emergency Response Authority for the Town of Crestone.
