A RESOLUTION RENUMBERING AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BUSINESSES
IN THE TOWN OF CRESTONE TO OBTAIN A BUSINESS LICENSE

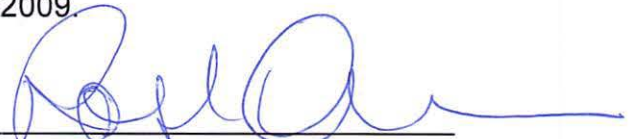
WHEREAS, Ordinance 1992-1, which was enacted by the Town of Crestone on April 8, 1992, required the filing of an affidavit of intent to run in a municipal election as a write in candidate and established a procedure to cancel said election; and

WHEREAS, an Ordinance requiring all business in the Town of Crestone to obtain a business license was likewise numbered 1992-1 and was enacted on June 3rd, 1992.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees hereby finds and determines that said latter Ordinance was inadvertently mis-numbered since it succeeded in time the passage of the previously mentioned ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that Ordinance 1992-1 (An Ordinance Requiring All Businesses in the Town of Crestone to Obtain a Business License) as passed by the Town of June 3, 1992, should be and hereby is renumbered as Ordinance 1992-2.
