

RESOLUTION NO. 002-2010

A RESOLUTION REFERRING THE ISSUE OF "TAVERN LICENSES"
TO THE TOWN ELECTORATE OF CRESTONE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, in accordance with a vote of the Crestone electorate on the 6th day of April, 2004, the Board of Trustees enacted Ordinance #2004-004 on the 12th day of April, 2004, limiting classes of malt, vinious and spirituous liquor licenses to those which *do not* include "Tavern Licenses" as described in C. R. S. § 12-47-412; and

WHEREAS, Melanie Snider presented a petition to the Town Board of Trustees on the 7th day of August, 2009, signed by 22 registered voters of the Town during May and June 2009 requesting that the Town "Change its ordinance" prohibiting Tavern Liquor licenses within the Town; and

WHEREAS, since this matter was originally decided by the Town electorate in accordance with the provisions of C.R.S. §12-47-105 (Local Option), it is appropriate that any repeal, reversal or amendment of such Ordinance likewise be decided by such electorate; and

WHEREAS, the next regular Town election is scheduled for April 6, 2010.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone that the following question shall be submitted to the Town Electorate upon the ballot at the regular Town election on April 6, 2010, to wit:

"Shall the Board of Trustees of the Town of Crestone enact an Ordinance repealing Ordinance #2004-004 which prohibited "Tavern Liquor Licenses" within the Town (and thereby allow such licenses)?

_____ YES (Repeal the Ordinance and allow tavern liquor licenses)

_____ NO (Continue the Ordinance and prohibit tavern liquor licenses)
