**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE
EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Provisions of C.R.S. 24-33.5-709 allow a local disaster emergency to be declared by the principal executive officer of a political subdivision of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, a local disaster emergency was declared by the Mayor of the Town of Crestone, Kairina Danforth, on the morning of April 1st, 2020 in connection with the corona virus, COVID-19, pandemic currently affecting the geographical area of the State of Colorado; and

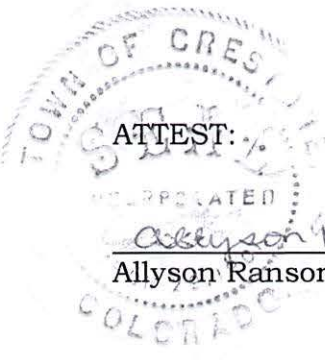
WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 24-33.5-709(1) the Town Board of Trustees may act to continue the emergency beyond the initial seven (7) day period statutorily allowed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Crestone will soon encounter other public gatherings necessitating the protection of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CRESTONE, COLORADO that the declaration of emergency declared by Mayor Danforth is hereby extended from its initial seven (7) days until, and including, the ~~31st~~ ^{11th} day of May, 2020, unless sooner rescinded by action of said Town Board.
